VAN BUREN YOUTH FAIR LARGE LIVESTOCK SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS:

The Van Buren Youth Fair Large Livestock Scholarship is available to a student attending college and/or an institution of higher learning who can meet the following requirements

1. Must be a graduating senior in high school becoming a first-year student in college or a first-year student in a higher education program or, a current college student who will be enrolled in college classes in the next academic year.
2. Must be active the last three (3) consecutive years in large livestock projects at the Van Buren Youth Fair.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. Scholarship is to be used for tuition, fees and books.
2. If the recipient of the scholarship quits or drops out of school, the remainder of the scholarship is to be refunded to the Van Buren Youth Fair Large Livestock Scholarship Fund.
3. Eligible applicants may be awarded this scholarship more than once. However, priority will be given to applicants that have not yet received this award.
